Camp Week 2: Each family is asked to send snacks for breaks during camp. Please provide at the beginning of camp. We suggest: fresh fruit (grapes, orange slices, cut-up melons—please leave on rinds), cookies, bars, muffins, breads, granola bars, string cheese or Gogurt. We also appreciate canisters of Lemonade mix.

Spirit Wear Order

Spirit Wear orders will be made through the Saylor website. There will be two orders, June 29th-July 13th and August 31st-Sept 14th. Link will be coming out soon by email.

Uniform Orders will be made via google form. This form will be emailed to everyone during band camp week 1. Students need to have shoes, gloves, and a blue band polo. The rest of the uniform will be checked out during band camp week 1

The Uniform

Each student will be issued a band uniform. It is a privilege to wear your band uniform. Here are a few bullet points to keep in mind:

- A clean crisp uniform helps us look better and stronger on the field. There is a lot of white on the uniforms. The students are responsible for keeping the uniform clean and will be responsible for cleaning the uniform if it gets dirty. Uniforms can only be dry cleaned (they CAN-NOT be washed in a household washing machine).
- In order for the uniforms to fit properly, students will need to wear a white compression type shirt (that fits tight to the body) underneath the uniform. That is the student's responsibility to provide. Please pick that up before the first football game.
- Each student will need white gloves. The gloves need to remain white and crisp. They should be washed between performances. These will need to be purchased via a google form that will be emailed out during band camp week 1.
- When wearing the entire uniform in public the entire uniform must be worn and worn properly. No unbuttoned jackets, hats worn without coats, etc. ALL ON OR ALL OFF...NO IN BETWEEN.
- You are encouraged to purchase your own marching band shoes. We are switching to a new marching shoe that is similar to our old ones but will be more stable and more comfortable. Shoes can be ordered with a google form that will be emailed out during the first week of band camp. If you can't or don't want to purchase shoes we will also be able to check out a used pair to students as a part of the uniform. .
- Students are not allowed to eat in the uniform. Hair must be pulled up inside of the hat (hair cannot be showing). Makeup and piercings of any kind are not allowed to be worn while in uniform.

Please keep in mind that all t-shirts are optional. Section T-shirts are handled exclusively by the section leaders and not by the directors or drum majors
